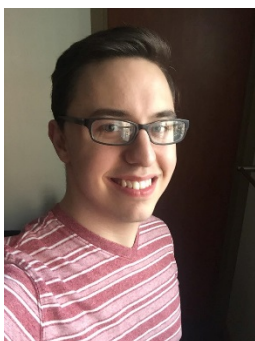


## A list of Students Participating in Service Learning in Japan 2018
